



So You Bought a

Now What?



WATERING

Fruit trees will require a healthy amount of water to produce the best fruit. As a rule of thumb, you can water 1-2 times in the winter, 2-3 times in the spring and fall, and 3-5 times in the summer.



FERTILIZING

Fruit trees benefit greatly from a nitrogen-based fertilizer once a month during the spring and fall months to push a full, tasty crop. Our Moon Dust is perfect for this purpose.



TRIMMING

Trimming should be done to remove old branches and make way for new growth. Be careful when pruning to never cut back more than 2/3 of your trees' and when your trees are flowering or fruit is setting, don't trim it back. These flowers turn into your fruit, if you trim during this time you could unknowingly take away from your harvest.
