

10 PLACES TO DISINFECT

in Your Manufacturing Plant

Leverage data-packed hourly PMs to help keep your plant safe

Keeping high-touch objects and surfaces clean helps prevent the spread COVID-19. Remember, cleaning just removes germs. Disinfecting kills them. You need to do both.

Not sure you have the right products? The United States Environmental Protection Agency provides a <u>searchable list of disinfectants</u> for use against COVID-19. Always read product instructions carefully, focusing on use and surface types, contact time, and safety precautions.



Focus on high-touch objects and surfaces. For each location, pack the PM with everything technicians need to work efficiently and safely. You can build one template and reuse the parts you need.



TOOLS & WORKSPACE SURFACES

Before and after each shift or rotation



MOVEABLE TRAYS & CONTAINERS

At least once per shift or between users



CONVEYOR BELTS

At least once in the morning and once in the afternoon



TRANSPORT VEHICLES

Before and after each use, making sure to include surfaces the previous driver could have touched like the door handle, radio, and navigation screen



FORKLIFTS

Before and after each use, making sure to include surfaces the previous driver could have touched like the mirror, seat belt, and control levers



FLOORS & WALLS

Periodically where frequently touched, andmop hard surfaces once a day



OFFICES, DESKS & MEETING ROOMS

At the end of each meeting and the end of each day



GENERAL SURFACES & BATHROOMS

At least four times per day, focusing on door handles, toilet levers, sinks, paper towel dispensers, and hand dryers



CAFETERIA

Three or more times per shift, timed after all breaks and meals



VENDING MACHINES

Three or more times per shift, timed after all breaks and meals
