- Hanken & SSE will match companies with interns by the end of February 2021 and after this companies can contact their intern(s) directly
- No employment contract is mandatory between the company and the intern, as the internship period is part of the Hanken & SSE Integration Program Business Lead
- The internship period is unpaid but paying a salary is optional, the interns receive a normal
- unemployment benefit from the TE-office during the internship period
- Hanken & SSE is responsible for a work-time insurance for all interns
