

At Martin Luther High School we have a Prom Processional and Prom Coronation before the actual Prom Dinner and Dance. The processional and coronation are held at school in the gym. All students going to prom should be at school on Saturday, April 24th by 5:00pm to line up for the processional. They are not required to walk for the processional. Family and friends are encouraged to come and watch the processional and the coronation. All coronation attendees must wear a mask while in the school building. Those who cannot attend can watch it livestream on the ML Facebook Page.

Students are called out by couple, alphabetically by girls last name to walk the gym. This gives family and friends a special opportunity for pictures. After all the couples have processed, the Prom Courts are announced. After the courts are announced, the crowning of King/Queen and Prince/Princess occurs. After the crowning, everyone is invited onto the gym floor to take pictures.

Prom Processional and Coronation is about 30-45 minutes. After this, students attending Prom are free to leave the school to head over to Muskego Lakes Country Club for the dinner and dancing portion of the evening. Dinner will start promptly at 7pm so students should plan accordingly. Students are responsible for their own transportation to and from school and to and from Muskego Lakes Country Club.

All Students will be required to wear a mask at Prom Coronation and at the dinner/dance when not eating or drinking.
