

THIS IS A REGULAR DAY OF SCHOOL:

- All academic classes will have lessons.
- Just as a in person school day, you may have homework outside of the regular lesson. All assignments will be open and need to be submitted by 11:59pm on 9/14. No makeup work for Virtual Day will be allowed.
- If you are ill on Monday and unable to complete work because of illness, your parent/guardian should follow normal attendance procedures (call the office to let them know).
- If a teacher chooses, and communicates that they will be doing a live lesson, they will also record it, but the live lesson will take place during normal class time. (i.e. 3rd Period 10:17-10:59)
- All lessons and assignments will be on Schoology, but the Office App may be needed to complete any word documents, PPT, etc. (the Office App is available on your mobile device app store if you do not have a computer)
- Teachers will communicate expectations for their individual classes and office hours they will have on Monday before you leave for the weekend.
- Passwords will not be given on Monday. Make sure you have all passwords and apps in order before you leave school on Friday. Not having your password is not a valid reason for missing work.

PSAT/NMSQT Test

Juniors! Please review the following information and click on the link if you're interested in taking the PSAT this year.

PSAT/NMSQT Test **Sign-up** - Due Monday, 9/14. Actual registration and payment will begin 9/21. Registration will run from 9/21-10/22 in Student Services.

What is it? The Preliminary-SAT College Test for Juniors and high achieving Sophomores. Juniors may qualify, based on score, to be recognized as a National Merit Scholar. NMSQT is National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test.

This is a sign-up to express interest in taking the test only. Your responses will help us determine how many tests we'll order. The actual test will take place on Thursday, October 29 from approximately 8:00-11:30 in the IMC. Cost is \$17.

Regular attendance at school is viewed to be essential for successful earning of credits at the high school level. The school day (including Student Help Days) should have priority status over outside activities.

Messages regarding attendance can be left on the school office voice mail 414-421-4000, please hold on the line and you will be connected to the general voice mail system at any time of the day or night. Parents/guardians may, also, notify the office staff in advance for absences, appointments, etc. by sending a note with your student or calling the office.

For The Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS), A maximum of 15 passengers are allowed on a bus at any given time. We will be flexible with students impacted by this.

ATTENDANCE REMINDERS:

- When a student must miss a school day for an illness, funeral, etc., or will be arriving later in the morning because of an appointment, please remember:
 - On the day of the absence, parents should call the school office by 9:00 AM. If the school office staff has not been contacted, parents will receive a phone call and email from the office staff. Once we receive a return call from a parent/guardian, the student's absence will be marked as excused. If we do not receive a return phone call/email, the absence will remain as "unexcused truant".
- When a student arrives late to school, they must come to the school office
 (Please ensure your student arrives to school with enough time to get to their
 lockers and get to class before 8:00a.m.). If a parent/guardian has not
 contacted the office regarding their student's late arrival, the student's
 attendance will be marked as "tardy". If a student arrives 20 minutes late, their
 attendance will be marked as "unexcused truant" unless a parent/guardian has
 contacted the office.

- If a student needs to leave school during the day for any reason, please send a
 note with the student or call the office by 9:00 AM. Students are then given
 a pass to leave.
- If a student becomes ill during the school day, they must come to the school office, and the office staff will promptly contact the parent/guardian. A Permit To Leave Campus will then be given to the student.
- If a student will be out of school for an extended time, they need to pick up a Pre-Planned Absence Form from the office. This form must be signed by the parents, all of the student's teachers, guidance counselor and the principal. Also, a note should be sent to the office.

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: For the safety of our students, faculty and staff only essential visitors will be allowed in the building during the school day. If you are picking up your student, please refrain from coming into the building. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.


