

MEDITECH User Verification Changes [GO-LIVE 11/00/20]

eMAR / BCMA - Network Password Authentication

PIN no longer required to access eMAR/BCTA

- Document in eMAR as normal
- Click [Submit] when done.
- Scan Patient Armband in summary screen as before.
- Click [Save and Exit] or [Save and Recompile] button
- Enter NT Password then press [F12] to file.
 - If co-sign required*

 - Enter Co-signer using their Meditech User ID
 - Note: N\LASTNAME then press [F9] to look-up co-signer's mnemonic if not known.

• Co-Signer enters NT Password then press [F12] to file.
