Procedure Guide for the Two Step Kit Central Line Maintenance

- Obtain the individually wrapped kit with Step 1 and Step 2 individually wrapped inside.
- Prepare the patient and provide education about the procedure.

Step 1

- Open sterile kit (using the outer towel as a work field)
- Sanitize hands with the individual packet of hand sanitizer in the kit







Rub until dry. DO NOT RIN

- 3. Don Mask
- 4. Mask and drape patient
- 5. Don sterile exam gloves
- 6. Stabilize the catheter, remove the old StatLock, and remove the dressing by pulling towards the insertion site (tape is provided to stabilize the line during this process and alcohol pads for cleaning the skin during removal).
- 7. Remove dirty gloves and prepare to use Step 2 kit

Step 2 (open cautiously as your hand sanitizer is in the fold of the kit)

- 1. Open sterile kit (use the outer towel as a sterile field)
- 2. Sanitize hands and drop StatLock onto the sterile field (obtained separate from the kit)
- 3. Don sterile exam gloves
- Frictional CHG scrub of insertion and statlock site (30 second scrub and 30 second dry)
- 5. Apply new StatLock
- 6. Apply Biopatch as indicated by facility protocol
- 7. Apply new transparent dressing (Tegaderm)
- 8. Date and time the dressing (The Tegaderm has a peel away label within the border for dating and timing the dressing. You can mark on this label with a standard pen and replace on the dressing after you have completed the sterile process and washed your hands).



Note: The kit does not include a StatLock. This item will need to be obtained as a separate item.
