Certified Athletic Trainer:

The Certified Athletic Trainer must have equivalent qualifications, competence and function in the same role as employed individuals performing the same or similar services at the facility.

Definition of Care or Service:

The Certified Athletic Trainer collaborates with physicians to provide preventative services, emergency care, clinical diagnosis, therapeutic intervention and rehabilitation of injuries and medical conditions. Scope of service may include:

- Apply and removes protective or injury-preventive devices and appliances, such as tape, bandages, drainage systems, plastic and synthetic casts, dressings and braces
- Fits and adjusts ambulation aids including canes, crutches and walkers
- Recognize and evaluate injuries
- Responsible for aiding physicians in procedures as needed
- Anticipates the moves of the surgeon and assists in the safe and efficient completion of the surgical procedure
- Facilitates hemostasis of the surgical site by performing suction, irrigation and sponging the operative site during a surgical procedure
- Assists with skin or external suturing and stapling
- Develop and carry out rehabilitation programs for injured athletes
- Plan and implement comprehensive programs to prevent injury and illness among athletes
- Perform administrative tasks, such as keeping records and writing reports on injuries and treatment programs
- Demonstrates Clinical and Service excellence behaviors to include code of HCA Healthcare conduct core fundamentals in daily interactions with patients, families, co-workers and physicians.

Setting(s):

• Healthcare facilities including but not limited to hospitals, outpatient treatment facilities.

Supervision:

- Indirect supervision by surgeon
- Collaborates with the primary care RN during treatments

Competencies:

The Certified Athletic Trainer will demonstrate:

- Safe and effective operation of therapy equipment
 - Applies equipment/products according to surgeon treatment orders
 - o Initiates and follows the manufacturer's recommendations for equipment and product use
 - Monitors patient tolerance of treatment, including equipment/product and reports same to RN and surgeon
- Accurate patient information review and evaluation
 - Uses at least two ways to identify patients before treating or performing a procedure
 - Verifies that the requested procedure correlates with the patient's clinical history, presentation and physician order
- Participates in the pre-procedure process to verify the correct procedure, for the correct patient, at the correct site and involves the patient in the verification process when possible
 - o Accesses the patient medical record appropriately
 - Documents in the medical record according to the facility standard/policy
 - Uses Performance Improvement Plan to improve patient safety
- Compliance: complies with department policy and procedures, safety/inspection control plans/OSHA guidelines, employee handbook, and standards of regulatory bodies (JCAHO, Medicare, CARF, etc.)
- Infection Prevention
 - Practices consistent hand hygiene
 - Uses personal protective equipment (PPE)
 - Complies with Isolation precautions
 - o Required immunizations per Division requirement
