## **Medical Transporter:**

The Medical Transporter must have equivalent qualifications, competence and function in the same role as employed individuals performing the same or similar services at the facility, as defined by facility job description.

#### Definition of Care or Service:

The Medical Transporter serves as a liaison between contract ambulance service and facility utilizing operational knowledge to facilitate patient transports in a safe, timely and appropriate manner. Scope of Service may include:

- Assists with level of service determination
- Completes patient demographic information
- Insures transport paperwork is completed and ready for ambulance crew
- Orders ambulances and insures scheduling information is correct
- Communicates anticipated early arrival or delay of crews for transport
- Tracks and reports on time performance
- Compiles and submits weekly reports
- Compiles and submits incident reports as needed
- Functions as an integral member of the discharge planning, care coordination and case management teams
- Demonstrates Clinical and Service excellence behaviors to include code of HCA Healthcare conduct core fundamentals in daily interactions with patients, families, co-workers and physicians.

#### Setting(s):

- Hospitals, Surgery Centers and Supply Distribution Centers
- Patient care areas, all settings

## Supervision:

- Direct supervision by the department leader of the patient's location
  - Indirect supervision by the hospital department leader who is responsible for EMS/case management/care coordination
