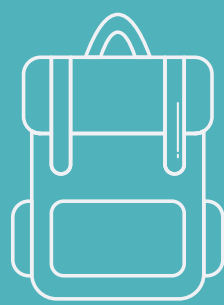

CLOTHES

You'll want to bring clothes that are okay to get a little dirty - it's camp, after all! Be sure to think about what will be appropriate for the weather, and consider labeling items to help keep track of everything.



- t-shirts/tops
- shorts or pants
- underclothes
- socks
- PAJAMAS!
- hat/bandana
- poncho/rain coat
- sweatshirt
- camp shoes - sandals and/or sneakers

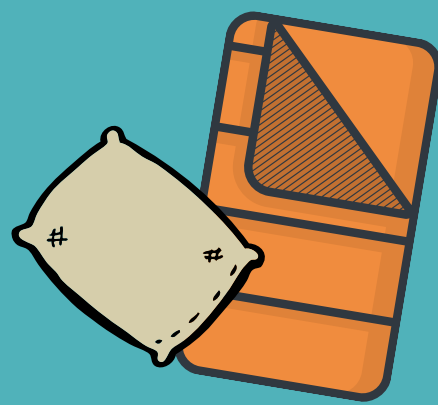
LINENS AND BEDDING

It's always a good idea to pack a towel, and you'll want to bring bedding that's okay to get a little dirty - again, it's camp, after all! Everyone will need to bring these items: *linens are not provided in cabins.*

- towel
- pillow
- sheets & blanket or sleeping bag

IF YOU'RE TENT CAMPING,
DON'T FORGET:

- tent
- bedroll (optional)



WATER ACTIVITY ITEMS

If you've signed up for pool or waterfront time, you'll want to make sure you pack these key items!



- swimsuit
- beach towel
- PFD for children under 30 lbs.
- water shoes (required for waterfront - no flip flops)

PERSONAL CARE ITEMS

All the important little things to stay fresh and healthy while at camp!

- toothbrush & toothpaste
- hairbrush/comb
- soap & shampoo
- reusable water bottle
- personal medications - *please keep in a locked/secured location for participant safety*
- sunscreen
- bug spray



2020 ESSENTIAL ITEMS

Some camp rules are a little different this year to help keep all of our guests and staff safe and in compliance with state regulations. Here's what you need to know:

- **Masks** must be carried for all participants age 3+ and must be worn when in close proximity with other family units. You may want to bring one per person for each day you will be at camp.
- **Hand sanitizer** should be used when a sink and soap are not nearby.



Reminder: guests must maintain at least 6 feet of distance from other family units - that's about 1 kayak paddle!

ODDS & ENDS & EXTRAS

Helpful items to have on hand and some optional items for family time.

- flashlight
- shower shoes
- laundry bag
- backpack or tote bag
- OPTIONAL IDEAS:
 - Bible for family devotions
 - games (like UNO!)
 - family yard games (like cornhole)
 - glow sticks
 - outdoor/camp chair



PLEASE DONOT BRING PETS, WEAPONS, POCKET KNIVES, ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES, AEROSOL SPRAY CANS, OR VALUABLES. **FOOD IS NOT ALLOWED TO BE STORED IN TENTS OR CABINS** DUE TO THE RISK OF INSECT/ANIMAL PROBLEMS.
