








San Jose 2020 General Plan (Approved in 1994)

- North San Jose Area
- Add Traffic Capacity Across I-880
- Added 2 Transportation Improvements:
 - 1. Widen Tasman Drive from 4 to 6 lanes between Zanker Road and I-880
 - 2. Widen Charcot Avenue from 2 to 4 lanes and Extend Charcot Avenue to Old Oakland Rd



Improve Connectivity in Region with Safe Multi-modal Facility


Objectives include:

Project Description




- Extend Charcot Ave from O'Toole Ave to Oakland Rd




Charcot Avenue Extension Section (Approaching O'Toole Avenue)




Charcot Avenue Extension Elevation (Spanning I-880)


