COVID-19 Surge

The CDC recently updated their <u>COVID-19 Surge</u> tool for hospital administrators. This spreadsheet-based tool allows users to produce estimates of the number of COVID-19 patients that need to be hospitalized, the number requiring ICU care and/or ventilator support. This can help facilities determine future product needs and identify any potential capacity challenges they may face. Our team understands how overwhelming it can be to deal with and plan for pandemic-related situations and we remain focused on supporting your needs at every turn.

Change in Traditional Healthcare

The COVID-19 pandemic and safe-social-distancing efforts have altered the delivery of and access to healthcare across the country.
