

School-based Partial Hospitalization Program

Providing high-quality intensive mental health care for local students

Through a strategic partnership designed to support both the significant emotional/mental health needs and education needs of students, **Community Services Group (CSG)** and **Lancaster-Lebanon Intermediate Unit 13 (IU13)** developed the School-based Partial Hospitalization Program. Both agencies will coordinate services to seamlessly complement and support each other in providing a successful therapeutic and educational environment for enrolled students.



The School-based Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP) is designed for children ages 13 to 21 years old whose needs cannot be met in a traditional classroom setting or by a lower level of care. This weekday, year-round program offers a blend of therapeutic and educational services provided to children in a group setting, and includes a multi-disciplinary team approach to treatment.

Services are designed to promote:

- Problem-solving skills and coping skills
- Improvement of overall mental wellness
- Self-confidence
- Successful return to a lower level of care and to the child's home school district
- Daily education support with certified and highly trained staff, to help students remain on track with their educational needs

Referrals are accepted from:

- Mental health professionals
- Hospitals
- School districts
- Psychiatrists
- Mental health case managers
- Managed care organizations

A team of certified medical professionals and education professionals delivers weekday services 5 days/week.

- Clinical Team: Program director, psychiatrist, nurse, mental health professionals and mental health worker.
- Educational Team: Program supervisor, teachers, and access to itinerant professionals (i.e., speech therapist), as needed
