Student Screening

In addition to mental health conditions like depression, trauma, anxiety, substance use, and eating disorders, our assessments uncover factors that may increase risk for suicidality, self-harm, and violence. Over 100 forms and assessments available on BH-Works, and additional tools can be added.

Plan of Care

BH-Works includes tools that help your team create and manage a student's plan of care. Leverage BH-Works to assign staff or student tasks, set goals, schedule evaluations, and document services and accommodations.

Referral Support & Tracking

Staff can refer students to services directly in BH-Works through a configurable referral directory, searching internal and external providers based on services offered, location, and availability. Referrals can be tracked and displayed on real-time data dashboards.

Telehealth

Staff users can initiate virtual visits through BH-Works. During the session, care providers can take notes, obtain consent, perform screenings, or share educational materials with the student. Authorized staff users can access an audit of the virtual visit, including who participated, the duration of the consult, and provider notes.

Real-Time Data Visualization & Reporting

Our system aggregates and displays de-identified data (information that could identify individual students has been removed) across schools, school districts, counties, and states in real time. To eliminate duplicate data entry, we work with schools to streamline district or state reporting requirements and configure dashboards based on your organization's individual needs.



How it works:



1 Student completes behavioral health assessment on tablet, desktop, or mobile device.



2 Results are automatically summarized and immediately ready for staff review.



3 Staff reviews results with student and makes referral to qualified provider within BH-Works.



4 Provider(s) receives email alert that referral was sent; providers can log into BH-Works to view screening report and staff notes.



5 Administrative users analyze de-identified data to identify trends and monitor program activity.
