




# Q1 How did your enrollment change for the 2020-2021 year?




# Q2 This fall, how are you offering education?



**Q3** What changes have you seen this year in terms of students living in school-owned housing? Has utilization:




**Q4** For 2020-2021 compared to the prior school year, do you anticipate that your spending will:






# Please rank the following financial challenges by level of impact to your organization
