Position Summary: The role of the Material Handler position is to help with the movement of inventory, while executing best practices for our inventory management system. Communicates regular with the materials team and executes transactions in a timely manner.

Responsibilities:

- Support activities related to procurement, storage, shipment of raw materials and receiving of incoming materials
- Assist with the Inspection process when necessary
- Maintains inventory location system in the ERP system (Syteline)
- Replenishes inventory at POU storage
- Replenishes inventory from internal departments such as Cables and Circuit City.
- Picks jobs accordingly for dedicated Value Stream
- Assist with visual reorder points
- Assist with cycle counts
- Assist with RGA's returns
- Effectively communicates inventory discrepancies
- Participates in material management improvement projects
- Must be able to back up team members for vacation days and be willing to work with team on vacation scheduling
- Work collectively within Materials Team to identify, implement, and maintain best practices within our business

Education/Training:

• High school diploma or general education degree (GED); or one to three months related experience and/or training; or a combination of both

Knowledge/Skills/Abilities:

- Organized, Dependable & Reliable
- Required: working knowledge of personal computers and common software
- Understanding of ERP system (Syteline) is a plus

- Ability to establish priorities, work independently and proceed with objectives with limited supervision
