2.0 Let Get Started - Basics

STEPS:

START

Confirm that you have the right permissions to your O365 tenant

1. Goto your SharePoint admin center page

https://admin.microsoft.com

To confirm this, sign in to https://admin.microsoft.com as a global or SharePoint admin. (If you see a message that you don't have permission to access the page, you don't have Office 365 administrator permissions in your organization). Please speak to IT.

This will need to be set.

YOU WILL NEED "GLOBAL ADMINISTRATOR" LEVEL PERMISSION TO ACCESS OR CREATE AN APP CATALOG SITE




2. Check the App Catalog exists






- 3. If you have access, click in the **SharePoint** link on the left-hand side.
- 4. Confirm if you have an App Catalog set up in your O365 environment.

screen






3.0 Installing the App in your O365 tenant

THIS IS BOTH SHAREPOINT AND TEAMS

STEPS:

START

NOTE: You will need to be an Administrator to install the app

1. Click on Apps for SharePoint. To confirm if the PDFMarkUp app is in the catalog



2. Search the word "PDF".

If this file is displayed, then the App is already deployed. If this is the latest version, then skip the next step.

3. If the file doesn't exist, download this file PDFMarkUpEditor to your desktop and upload to your tenant Apps for SharePoint



4. Select the check box to indicate that the solution can be deployed automatically across all sites in the organization.



5. Select **Deploy**

At this point, the app has been deployed, but could take 20 minutes for a tenant wide deployment to be functionality enabled.



6. Sync the App to Teams

NOTE: You will need to be paying for a Teams subscription for this to work in Teams


Click **Sync** to Teams

7. Add the App to Teams



On the left side bar of Teams, search on the PDF editor and select it

- 8. Add to a Teams
- 9. Add to The Team, Channel

Select a channel to start using PDF Editor

PDF Editor will be available for the entire team, but you can start using it in the channel you choose.



- 10. Click Set up a Tab
- 11. Click Save





All PDF files in the Channel will be displayed.

END- The PDFMarkUp Tool App is installed and deployed to your tenant





4.0 Configuration of the App to your O365 tenant

START - By design, the PDF Editor has been pushed to all current and future site collections in this tenant.


IF YOUR DOCUMENT LIBRARY IS MODERN, THEN NO FURTHER ACTION IS

Classic Only

If there is a library that is classic, then the following steps need to be done on each library.

- 1. Select the wheel on the top right-hand corner
- 2. Select Library setting
- 3. Select Advanced Setting
- 4. Select New experience and Click Ok



List experience

Select the experience you want use for this list. The new experience is faster, has more features, and works better across different devices.


7. Approve MS Graph Permissions [for OneDrive]

Open up the SharePoint admin portal - https://{your domain}-admin.sharepoint.com/

Expand the 'Advanced' Tab and click API access

Expand Organization-wide and look for PDF MarkUp - [Files.ReadWrite.All & Sites.ReadWrite.All]






Click on one at a time, then click Approve
