### Talent

- Prince William is the 10th most diverse county in the country.
- Virginia is ranked #1 Top State for Business by CNBC for two years running and ranked #1 for cybersecurity in Business Facilities magazine with a cybersecurity workforce of 71,000 employees, the largest on the East Coast.
- Virginia's \$2B+ Tech Talent Investment Program aims to double the number of graduates each year in computer science and related fields.

### Customers

- Home to Marine Corps Base Quantico and just south of Fort Belvoir Army installation along the Potomac River, with 100 federal agencies and more than 100,000 military personnel and civilian employees.
- Nearly 20% of \$665 billion of prime contract dollars awarded by the federal government in 2020 were won by companies headquartered in this region.

### Connection

- 70 percent of the world's internet goes through Northern Virginia with 1376 MW of capacity. Prince William offers excellent risk mitigation in data center capacity.
