COVID-19 Grant Programs and Incentives



Over the past weeks and months, the Prince William Board of County Supervisors has approved \$18 million from CARES Act funding for the creation of several grant and incentive programs designed to assist businesses and residents negatively impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic. These programs are all open and currently accepting applications while funds are available or until the end of this year. Here are some of them:

- [ELEVATE](#) - provides training programs, support services, and career assistance
- [Small Business Relief Micro-Grants](#) - grants of up to \$10,000 to qualified small businesses
- [Capital Investment and Innovation Grant](#) - grants of up to \$200,000 for businesses and building owners that make physical improvements or innovate a business model
- [Construction and Renovation Permit Rebate](#) - rebates of up to \$2,000 for permitting fees for renovations and new construction projects

- [Temporary Activity Permit](#) - to assist restaurants, dining, and craft beverage establishments with temporary outdoor dining accommodations and curbside pickup

Rebuild VA Grant Fund

Rebuild VA has expanded its eligibility criteria to allow more small businesses to apply. The program is intended to assist small businesses and non-profits whose normal operations were disrupted by COVID-19. Qualified businesses are eligible to receive grants of up to \$10,000. [Read more.](#)
