ECONOMIC RECOVERY PROGRAMS

In 2020, the Prince William Board of County Supervisors approved \$18 million of CARES Act funding for the creation of several grant and incentive programs designed to assist businesses and residents negatively impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic. The following are some of the programs that are currently accepting applications:



IGNITE Grant

Offers cash grants of \$25,000 and \$50,000 to selected high-growth companies and tech catalyst organizations. [Read more.](#)

Supports eligible underserved small businesses by pairing them up with coaches and giving them one-on-one access to expertise in business strategy, marketing, and finance.

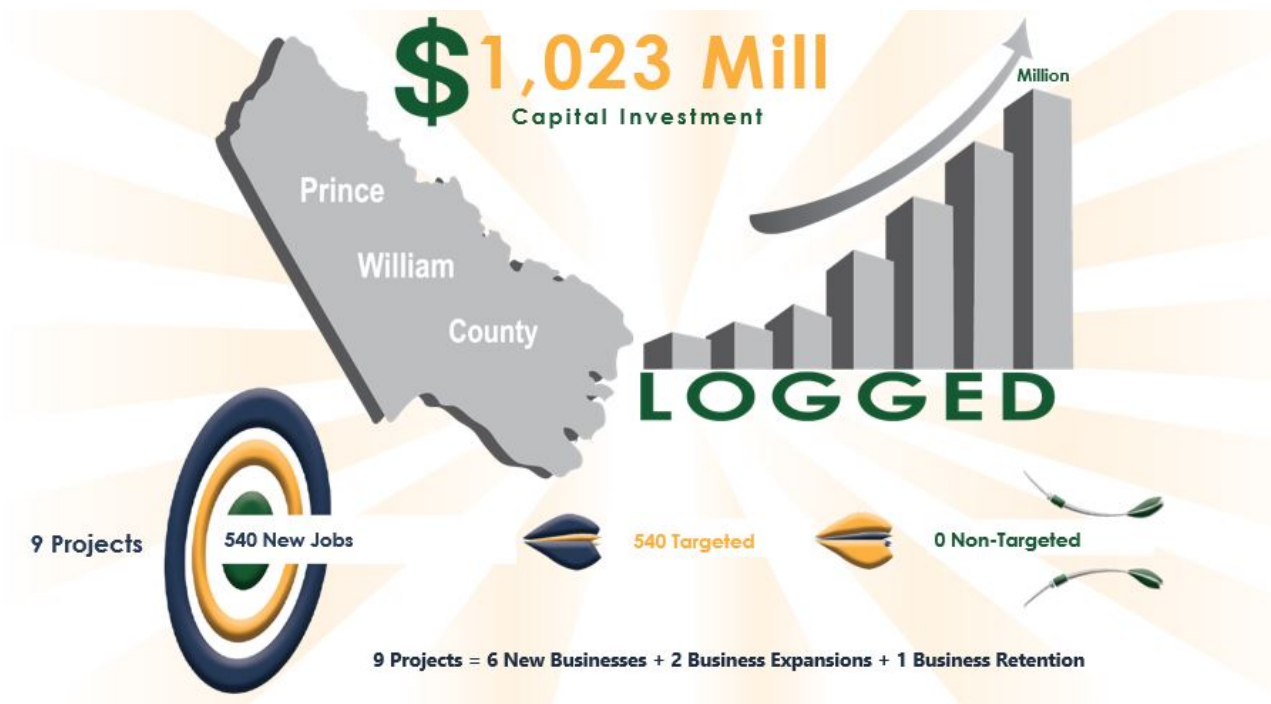


PrinceWilliamStrong Pledge

PROJECT SUCCESSES: OCT-DEC 2020

The Department concluded 2020 by successfully closing 9 projects in the three months to December. These projects expect to undertake just over \$1 billion in capital expenditure and create 540 new jobs. They involve the retention of 1 business with 12 employees, the expansion of 2 local businesses adding a total of 25 new jobs; and the decision by 6 companies to locate their operations in Prince William County, adding a further 515 new jobs. The associated companies will support the diversification of the county's economic base as they operate within a range of industries including: life sciences, distribution, ICT and data centers.
