Election Day 2020 Study

In a study launched the day before the 2020 Election Day, we asked 500 people about their voting plans.

Do you plan on voting in the 2020 Presidential Election?

91% of respondents stated that they planned to cast a ballot for their presidential candidate of choice.

6% of respondents stated that they will vote for the first time this Election Day.

95% of respondents who voted in the 2020 Election stated that their parents were active voters in past Presidential Elections

Thinking back to when you were growing up, do you remember your parents voting in presidential elections?

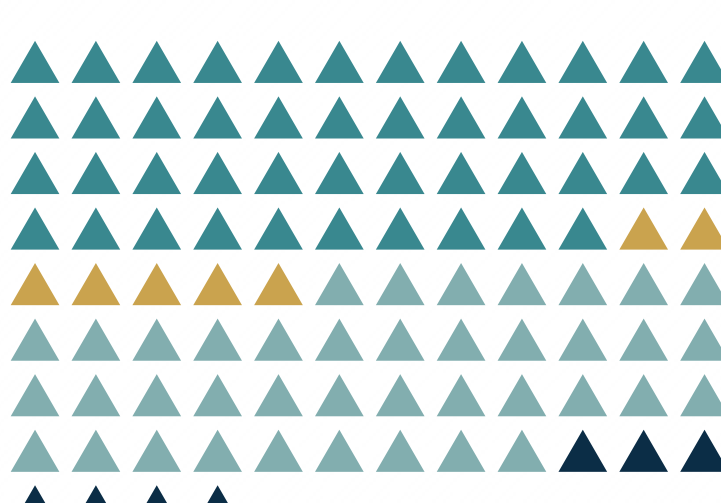
■ Yes (71%)
