




Decoding of color codes in Promotion Scheduler

Color codes are used in Promotion Scheduler to quickly provide an overview of the promotion state and promotion result.

Promotion result is based on your result in the cost-benefit analysis.



| Co-210018 | Light green = Planned Promotion with a positive <u>supplier</u> Cost-benefit. |

| Co-210017 | Light red = Planned Promotion with a negative <u>supplier</u> Cost-benefit and negative Gross margin. |
| Co-210023 | Light orange = Planned Promotion with a negative <u>supplier</u> Cost-benefit and positive Gross margin. |
| Co-210018 | Bright and light green = Confirmed Promotion with a positive <u>supplier</u> Cost-benefit. |
| Co-210017 | Bright and light red = Confirmed Promotion with a negative <u>supplier</u> Cost-benefit and negative Gross margin. |
| Co-210023 | Bright and light orange = Confirmed Promotion with a negative <u>supplier</u> Cost-benefit and positive Gross margin. |
| Co-210018 | Bright green = Completed Promotion with a positive supplier Cost-benefit. |
| Co-210017 | Bright red = Completed Promotion with a negative <u>supplier</u> Cost-benefit and negative Gross margin. |
| Co-210023 | Bright Orange = Completed Promotion with a negative supplier Cost-benefit and positive Gross margin. |
