Item (Rule) 250, Definition of or Specifications for Cylinders, is amended as follows:

⇒ITEM 250

DEFINITION OF OR SPECIFICATIONS FOR CYLINDERS

Cylinders are used for shipping materials under pressure and must be constructed in conformance with the applicable requirements of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR). Materials authorized in this Classification to be shipped in steel cylinders will also be accepted in cylinders of other construction, provided that such materials are specifically authorized in the DOT's regulations or by DOT special permit to be shipped in such cylinders.

Cylinders tendered for shipment on lift truck skids, pallets or platforms must be secured to the lift truck skid, pallet or platform in a manner to withstand the normal rigors of the less-than-truckload environment. Reels must have a core and two ends or heads of equal size with a diameter of 10 inches or more. When tendered on lift truck skids, pallets or platforms, reels must be securely fastened to the lift truck skid, pallet or platform, which must be of sufficient design, size and strength to support the size and weight of the reel and the article wound thereon. ⇒Except where more specifically provided in individual items, the last layer of the article must be lagged or wrapped between the flanges of the ends or heads with packaging material extending full width of the wound article and of sufficient strength to withstand the normal rigors of the less-than-truckload environment.
