

The Western Clinical Alliance (WCA) is a clinically integrated network which joins together physicians across our community into a single comprehensive care delivery network. For Renown employees covered under our Hometown Health insurance, this means you have access to the ever-growing WCA group of providers, which keeps healthcare costs affordable because seeing a WCA provider costs the same as if you were seeing a Renown provider.

Step 1: Sign into your Hometown Health <u>online account</u>. If you don't have an account already, you can create one. **NOTE:** You'll need your insurance card with your member id number to create that account.




Step 2: Verify you are signed in by checking for your name and network is showing in the top right corner of the page. If not, click **Sign In** to log into your account. Also, make sure the **Only My Network** box is checked.



Step 3: You can search for providers a couple ways.


Search by Provider Type

 Search using the Provider Type drop down button and choose an option. In the example below, we are using Primary Care Providers. Click Search.




Once the provider list opens, look in the Additional Information box and you will see a note saying Western
Clinical Alliance Provider. In the example below, Abraham, Cheruba, MD shows the Western Clinical Alliance
note but Abia, Loreydei B, APRN does not.

NOTE: You can look at the Provider Group to see if the provider is also a Renown provider.




Search for a Facility or Specific Provider by Name

• Search using the **Provider Name or Facility Name box**. In the example below, we are looking for Reno Orthopedic Clinic facility. Click **Search**.




• This will populate a list of all the facility's locations and the providers associated with that specific facility. The Western Clinical Alliance providers will be listed first, making them easy to find. Look at the **Additional** Information box to verify it says *Western Clinical Alliance Provider*.

NOTE: Not all providers in the facility will be WCA providers so you will need to look carefully to ensure you will pay the lowest copay.



Search by Specialty

Search using the Specialty dropdown menu. In the example below, we are looking for Neurology. Click Search.



Once the provider list opens, look in the Additional Information box and you will see a note saying Western
 Clinical Alliance Provider. In the example below, Ania, Rolando, MD is a WCA Provider but Ansarinia, Mehdi, MD is not.

NOTE: You can look at the Provider Group to see if the provider is also a Renown provider.
