Do I qualify for a voucher through the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program?

Your child qualifies for the MPCP program IF:

1. You and the child live at an address in the City of Milwaukee.
2. Your income qualifies for the MPCP. Here are the income limits based on family size:

**Table 1 – MPCP and RPCP Income Limits**  
**300% of the Federal Poverty Level for 2021-22**

<u>Family Size</u>	<u>Maximum Yearly Income*</u>
1	\$38,280
2	\$51,720
3	\$65,160
4	\$78,600
5	\$92,040
6	\$105,480

**For each additional member add \$13,440**

the prior year, he or she does not need to meet the income limits. Family income includes the income of the student's parent(s)/legal guardian(s) that reside in the same household as the student applicant. If the student's parents/legal guardians that reside in the same household are married, their income is reduced by \$7,000 when determining income eligibility for the program (*i.e. married family income minus \$7,000*). For example, if a family of four with parents that are married has an income of \$60,000, subtract \$7,000 from their income and compare that amount (\$53,000) to the income limit for a family of four in the appropriate table below. Family size includes parents/legal guardians and their children by birth, marriage or adoption that reside in the same household as the student applicant.

3. You DO NOT need to qualify for the income requirements if your child received a voucher through the MPCP at St. Marcus or any other school last school year OR if they were on a waiting list.
