

## II. Primary Grades Uniform Policy

Must be clean, proper and free of wrinkles. Students not dressed appropriately will not be permitted to participate in school events, including those not meeting the expectations for given “dressdown” days.

	REQUIRED UNIFORM ITEMS	PROHIBITED - NO EXCEPTIONS
<b>TOPS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- ALL: PLAIN button-down short or long-sleeve dress shirt <i>with</i> white undershirt.</li> <li>- GIRLS may use a straight or rounded collar.</li> <li>- OPTIONAL: Plain navy blue, white or red uniform sweater or vest</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Blouses that have any colors or decorative accents ANYWHERE (no ruffles, straps, etc.)</li> <li>- Polo shirts of any type</li> <li>- Long-sleeved shirts under short-sleeved shirts</li> <li>- Sweatshirts, pullovers, hoodies, zip-ups</li> </ul>
<b>BOTTOMS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Navy blue uniform dress pants (navy blue uniform dress shorts are permitted May through September)</li> <li>- GIRLS: PLAIN navy blue straight or pleated dress skirt or jumper (matching navy blue shorts permitted underneath)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Skirts or capri, tight, stretch, cargo or skinny-style pants (tight at ankle)</li> <li>- Leggings or footless tights</li> <li>- Skorts or shorts for girls</li> </ul>
<b>TIE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- BOYS: navy-blue uniform tie</li> <li>- GIRLS: red crossover uniform tie</li> <li>- 4TH GRADE HONOR ROLL (GPA &gt; 3.5): striped Red/Blue/Gold/Silver tie that is issued at awards ceremony</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Non-Awarded ties (anything other than a blue uniform tie must be awarded at quarterly awards ceremony)</li> </ul>
<b>SOCKS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- PLAIN white, navy blue, red or black socks.</li> <li>- GIRLS: PLAIN white, navy blue, red, or black ankle or knee-high socks or tights</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Colors other than what was indicated as approved uniform pieces</li> </ul>
<b>SHOES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- PLAIN all-black flat dress or tennis shoes that cover heel, have all black soles, and have all black laces and/or a black strap (INCLUDES logos, soles, brand names, etc - the shoe must be ENTIRELY black)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Slip-on shoes without a strap or laces</li> <li>- Girls heeled or open-back dress shoes or boots</li> <li>- Colors of any type other than black on the laces, strap, soles or anywhere on the shoe</li> </ul>
<b>BELT</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- PLAIN solid-black dress belt required for all boys and optional for girls</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Colors or large decorative belts</li> </ul>
<b>EXTRAS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- GIRLS: May wear PLAIN navy blue, red, white or black accessories to match the uniform (patterned or solid), such as headbands and hair pieces.</li> <li>- PIERCINGS: single-pierced ears okay for GIRLS only, but</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Fake glasses or sunglasses</li> <li>- Fake/unnatural hair colors (red, blue, green, pink, purple, etc.</li> <li>- BOYS: NO PIERCINGS OR EARRINGS VISIBLE OR COVERED.</li> </ul>

### GIRLS: PROHIBITED ACCESSORIES

- PIERCINGS: more than one piercing is not permitted; no chains, connectors, clip-on/fake earrings; no hoop earrings larger than a quarter
- JEWELRY: no excessive jewelry, choker necklaces, or wearing lip gloss
- HAIR: No distracting hair accessories; must be less than 3” thick, nothing across forehead or raised/protruding (i.e. fuzzy balls or cat ears); no colors other than PLAIN navy blue, red, white or black.
- PURSES: No carrying around purses (keep in backpack)
