Aftercare Programs

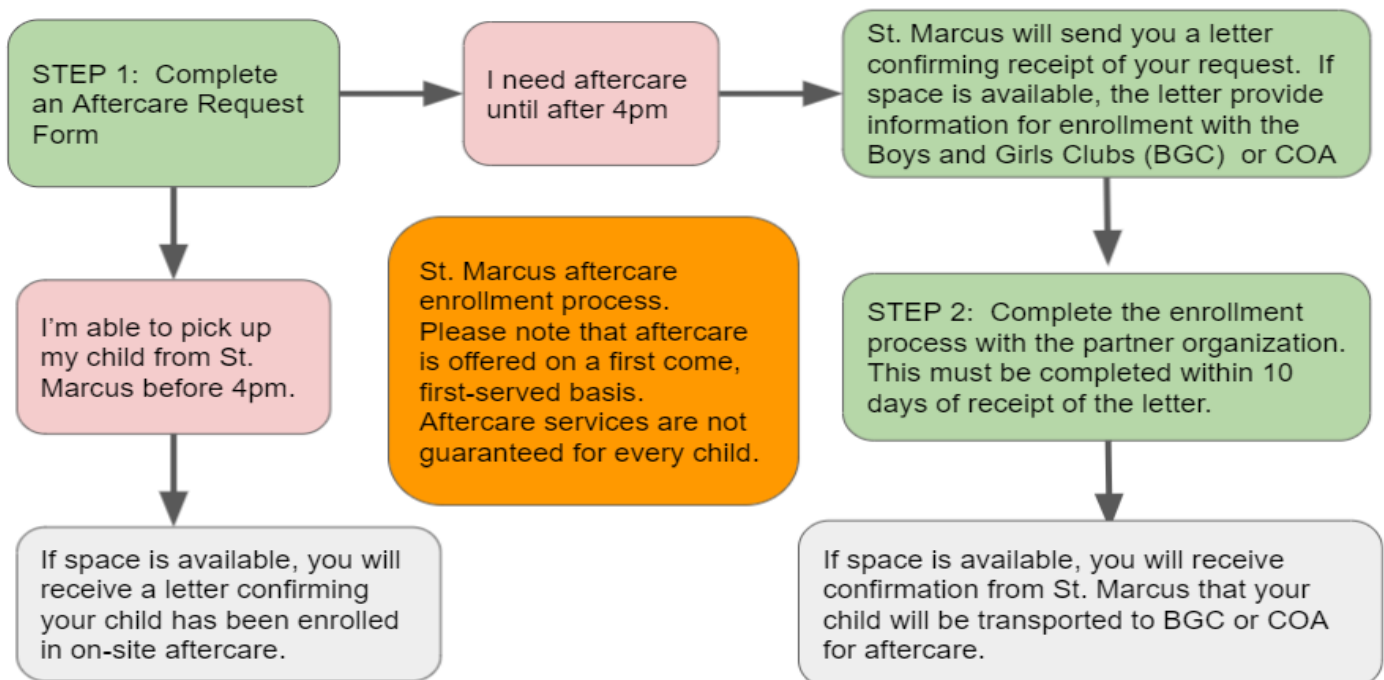
Two aftercare options are available for students in grades K4-8:

Option #1: On-site aftercare. **This is only provided on each campus until 4pm.** There is a \$4 daily charge per student, maximum \$8/day per family. Wisconsin Shares may NOT be used for this expense.

Option #2: Transportation to a partner organization for off-site aftercare. Currently, St. Marcus is partnering with two organizations to provide off-site aftercare:

- COA (2 different locations)
 - 909 E. Garfield Avenue (North Campus students and their siblings)
 - MLK Jr. Elementary School at 3275 N. 3rd Street (Harambee Campus students)
 - COA aftercare services do not start until September 7th.
 - Students assigned to COA will be on-site until September 7th with a latest pick-up time of 5pm.
- Hillside Boys and Girls Club
 - Located at 611 W. Cherry Street
 - Mainly for students at the Main Campus and their siblings
 - Maximum enrollment 70

Overview of Enrollment Process:



Aftercare Request:

- To be guaranteed a seat in aftercare, parents should submit a [REQUEST FORM](#)
- Parents are accommodated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Aftercare Enrollment:

- After submitting a request form, parents will be assigned either to on-site aftercare or the BGC program, based on availability and pick-up time. Seats are limited.
- Parents who are assigned to BGC or COA will need to also complete the enrollment process through BGC and COA. This must be completed within 10 days in order to keep your seat on the school bus to aftercare.

Details About Aftercare at the Boys and Girls Club

- Seats are limited. Available on a first come-first-served basis.
- Aftercare available until 7pm
- Please see enrollment information for cost and payment options. Wisconsin Shares may be used.
- Serves students in grades K4-8
- Includes dinner.
- If allocated a seat, students will need to enroll in the COA program.
- Students will be taken to BGC by St. Marcus and picked up by parents at BGC 611 W. Cherry Street.

Details About Aftercare at COA

- Seats are limited. Available on a first come-first-served basis.
- COA services start on September 7th. Between the start of school and September 7th, students assigned to COA will have on-site aftercare which ends at 4pm.
- Aftercare available until 6pm
- Please see enrollment information for cost and payment options. Wisconsin Shares may be used.
- Serves students in grades K4-8
- Includes dinner.
- If allocated a seat, students will need to enroll in the BGC program.
- Students will be taken to BGC by St. Marcus and picked up by parents at COA
- Pick up location is in the parking lot off North Avenue to the right around the Reservoir Curve.

Other Information:

- Students who are signed up for aftercare do not need to attend every day.
- Students who are signed up for aftercare and are in sports or clubs may attend aftercare some days and participate in their sport on other days.
- Siblings of students who are staying on-site for sports must be picked up at dismissal time or be signed up for aftercare at the BGC. Siblings may not stay on site during a sibling's sports practice.

Please note that students who are assigned to off-site aftercare MAY NOT attend on-site aftercare. On-site aftercare has limited capacity and is only for students who have been enrolled in the program.
