


XOMETRY SMALL MANUFACTURING INDEX

64% of U.S. Small Manufacturers Anticipate Growth as Business Confidence Rebounds to Pre-COVID Levels

How would you rate your anticipated business for the next six months?

Over the next six months, 64% of small manufacturers anticipate a mild- to strong-increase in business.





Compared to the same time last year, business for small manufacturers has improved.

The report showed a big rebound in business confidence for manufacturers, with 56% reporting an increase in business, compared to the same time last year.

Emerging concerns for small manufacturers.

As small manufacturers begin to look ahead to a post-COVID world, 44% identified the rising costs of materials and tooling as their number one concern.



Small manufacturers reported a shift in their customer base as many factories resumed operations after idle periods in 2020.

Small manufacturers anticipate Industrial Machining to make up the largest share of their business for the next six months. Automotive rose 107% compared to the same time last year and the Medical industry remains a steady source of work, with manufacturers anticipating it to make up around 27% of their business.
