



Safe Haven Family Shelter has 35 years of experience in the changing field of family homelessness with proactive programs, evidence based practices and trauma informed care. They lead Middle Tennessee’s efforts to house, support, empower and advocate for families experiencing homelessness.

Safe Haven is the premier shelter-to-housing program of its kind in Middle Tennessee that accepts the entire homeless family. They keep the family together and provide comprehensive services that empower them to achieve lasting self-sufficiency. Safe Haven helps families experiencing homelessness by providing for their immediate needs of shelter and stability. They operate through effective and results-driven programs, integrating services that are evidence-based.

Their housing first model, coupled with wrap around services is designed to give families the necessary tools to achieve lasting self-sufficiency, stable employment and secured housing. A home is so much more than a house. It is the main foundation for a family to thrive. It provides security, safety, togetherness, opportunity and love. In 2019, Safe Haven added prevention and increased housing services, doubling the amount of families served and housed annually. They housed over 100 families and served 300 families.

With Kyle Allen as one of Safe Haven’s Board of Directors, Vaco Nashville is actively involved in volunteering with Safe Haven through charitable events, sponsorships, and mentoring. Most recently, the Vaco team went to Safe Haven’s shelter and decorated Christmas trees with the families staying there over the holiday season. 🎄
