CHALLENGES:

There would be limited access to the facility, no on-site storage for the equipment, and any delivery would have to be coordinated in a way that does not interfere with the construction in each wing.

CME SOLUTION:

We were able to transport the equipment from a small dock and carry out a phased, room-by-room installation, while also protecting their newly furnished flooring.
