

Synapse[®] EIS System Administration Remote Course

NRS-EISADM-R

INTENDED AUDIENCE:

This 15-hour remote course is intended for Synapse EIS administrators and technical support staff looking to enhance their understanding of the latest Fujifilm Synapse EIS release, its architecture, operational considerations, and systems management.

TRAINING SYSTEM:

Registered participants will be provided a username, password, and URL to remotely access the Synapse EIS v7 training system via Chrome or IE 11. Each participant must have access to a PC with the current EIS release in-stalled through one of these two browsers, as well as internet access. We also recommend that participants have administrator access or IT staff on hand to assist with any potential troubleshooting needs.

Please note that the EIS software is hosted in Fujifilm's secure data centers and avoids the need to download content to the PC. The patient database used for this course also houses fictitious information; no real patient data will be used in this course.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The Synapse EIS System Administration Remote Course is an online training program used to enhance understanding of EIS in the Radiology workflow. Instruction will be provided on how to optimize the software for role-specific functionalities. The workflows covered in this course include Registration, Scheduling, Precertification, Technologist, and Radiologist. Instruction will also be provided on the implementation of clinical workflows and informatics in radiology. The course will include a basic overview and instruction on the integration of Synapse EIS and PACS, as well as the authentication methods used.

This course includes registration for **up to two participants**.

Participants can expect to leave the course with applicable knowledge about operating and administering the Synapse EIS system, as well as the ability to instruct end users in using the software.
