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HOW TO PURCHASE SOLUTIONS ON GSA ADVANTAGE!:

<u>GSA Advantage!</u> is an online shopping and ordering system for government customers to purchase products and services from thousands of different government contractors. The federal government is authorized to make purchases on GSA Advantage! via:

- Government Commercial Purchase Card (GSA SmartPay)
- GSA Activity Address Code (ACC)
- Department of Defense Activity Address Code (DoDAAC)
 - *Please note this is limited to purchases of GSA Global Supply items

State, Local, and Education (SLED) government customers are also authorized to purchase products and services on GSA Advantage! through the <u>Cooperative Purchasing Program</u> and <u>the Disaster Recovery Purchasing Program</u>. Please note that SLED government customers are limited to using a state or local government issued credit card for purchases. Visit <u>GSA's webpage on GSA Advantage!</u> to learn more about how government customers can utilize the platform to purchase products.

HOW TO PURCHASE SOLUTIONS ON GSA EBUY:

GSA Schedule contractors who have their current price catalog posted to GSA Advantage! are eligible to respond to solicitations posted on <u>GSA eBuy</u>. Federal government agencies (Eligible Buyers) may prepare and post Requests for Information (RFIs), Requests for Proposal (RFPs) or Requests for Question (RFQs) for products or services deemed necessary for the government under a GSA Schedule. Similar to GSA Advantage!, State, Local, and Education (SLED) Government customers have the same abilities mentioned above as federal government agencies under the Cooperative Purchasing Program and the Disaster Recovery Purchasing Program.

Please note that government users who have an active GSA Advantage! account may also use eBuy. It is also worth mentioning that each solicitation posted on eBuy is assigned to a specific GSA Schedule Special Item Number (SIN) category, or GWAC/Network Services and Telecommunications functional category by the buyer.
