Handwriting Paper	Encourage correct size, spacing, and placement of letters when writing
Golf Pencils Variety of Pencil Grips	Assist with proper pencil grasp
Finger Spacer	Encourage appropriate spacing between words
Binder (for slant board)	Assist with proper position for writing
Eraser Colored Pencils	For writing and visual motor activities
Dry Erase Marker and White Board	For writing and visual motor activities, group activities/participation, charting/graphing for visual organization of language, phonological awareness
Theraputty Play-Doh	For hand strength exercises, sensory input, making shapes/letters, requesting and eliciting language
Therapy Band	For upper and lower body strength exercises, sensory input
Tennis Ball Buddy	For hand strength and eye-hand coordination exercises, sensory input
Small Manipulatives	For hand strength and manipulation exercises, eye-hand coordination exercises, sensory input, and incorporation of language concepts
Wikki Stix	For eye-hand coordination exercises, making shapes and letters, sensory input
Animal Tongs	For hand strength and coordination exercises, help with scissor skills, and sensory input
Popsicle Sticks	For eye-hand coordination exercises, making shapes and letters, target words
Fidgets	For sensory input
Dice	For eye-hand coordination exercises, speech-language exercises, gross motor exercises
Spot It! Travel Game	For eye-hand coordination exercises, receptive and expressive language, articulation exercises
Bubbles	For eye-hand coordination exercises, gross motor exercises, requesting and eliciting language

Jump Rope	For movement breaks and gross motor exercises, requesting and eliciting language
Zoom Ball Ball	For movement breaks, eye hand coordination, and gross motor exercises, requesting and eliciting language
Beach Ball	For movement breaks, gross motor exercises, requesting and eliciting language, and as a seating option

Brown Paper Bags	Sorting, receptive and expressive language activities, containment of therapy items
