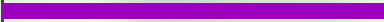

Max THC (and Max CBD) are calculated values for total cannabinoids after heating, assuming complete decarboxylation of the acid to the neutral form. It is calculated based on the weight loss of the acid group during decarboxylation: Max THC = (0.877 x THCA) + THC. This calculation does not include other cannabinoid isomers (eg. D8-THC and exo-THC). ND = None detected above the limits of detection (LOD), which is one third of LOQ.

Client sample analysis was performed using full evaporative technique (FET) headspace sample delivery and gas chromatographic (GC) compound separation. A combination of flame ionization detection (FID) and/or mass spectrometric (MS) detection with mass spectral confirmation against the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Mass Spectral Database, Revision 2017 were used. Chromatographic and/or mass spectral data were processed by quantitatively comparing the analytical peak areas against calibration curves prepared from certified reference standards.
