

Coachbuilt (lorry or truck chassis)

Coachbuilt Lorry Derived motorhomes are the European equivalent of the large USA RV.

The best way to think of these is in similar terms to a Coachbuilt motorhome, but where the base chassis is a lorry, instead of a van/light commercial vehicle. The driving cab is retained and a very large habitation unit is coachbuilt on the rear.

Mercedes and Iveco base lorry units are commonly used for these motorhomes, and they will often feature "slideouts" to extend the habitation area.

This type of motorhome is a popular choice for "Race trucks" – with space for a car, tools and so on to the rear of the living space
