



Panel van derived

Panel van derived motorhomes (sometimes termed PVCS [Panel Van Conversions]) are larger than Campers/People Carrier Derived Motorhomes.

Panel Van Derived Motorhomes are usually twin berth (sometimes bunkbeds), and sometimes feature a high roof, but not normally a pop-top roof.

The base chassis will typically be a van chassis with a GVW of 3,000kg or more.

Compare and contrast these vehicles to Coachbuilt motorhomes – note how the whole panel van body is retained, whereas with Coachbuilt motorhomes only the van cab is retained.
