## Nason Center for Assisted Living Visitation Guidelines

We will reopen the Nason Center for outdoor/outside visits only at this time beginning on Monday June 22, 2020.

Starting out, we will open for outdoor/outside visitation at the Nason Center for Assisted Living during the following days and times:

- Monday through Saturday: 1:00p.m. 4:00p.m.
- Evening Visits Monday and Wednesday: 6:00p.m. 7:00p.m.

For now, visits in assisted living are to be limited to a designated area outside of the Nason Center and visitors are not permitted in the buildings.

After passing the screening checkpoint, please head to the Nason Center parking lot and remain in your car until your loved one is seated at the designated visit area.

## **General Requirements:**

- Please reschedule your visit if you are feeling under the weather to any degree
- In the case of inclement weather, or a heat advisory, visits will not take place
- Visitors will be screened at the checkpoint entering our campus on Euclid Ave and must pass that screening, including temperature check, in order to visit
  - o Body Temperature must be under 100.4°
- All visitors are required to wear a face covering/mask during the visit
- Please maintain a 6 foot social distance during the visit
- Hand sanitizer will be available for use prior and after your visit
- All visits will be monitored by a team member to ensure safety guidelines
- Each visit area will be sanitized and disinfected pre/post visit
- Please arrive promptly for your visit
- Please no food or drink during the visit
- Please no gifts or items are to be brought to the visit; please drop these items off at the checkpoint
- Please no pets/animals during the visits
- In an effort to accommodate all Nason residents, families, and friends who wish to visit, at this time we are limiting each resident to one visit per week
- All of these guidelines are subject to change as we continue to gradually reopen

We ask that you and your guests follow these important guidelines, for your safety and the safety of everyone around you:

What days per week can family and friends visit?	Monday – Saturday
What is the time frame for visits to occur?	Monday – Saturday 1:00p.m. – 4:00p.m.
	Monday and Wednesday Evenings 6:00p.m. – 7:00p.m.
Where can the visit occur?	Outside in designated area
