CERTIFICATION ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- ▶ Hold a current, active RN license in a state or territory of the United States or hold the professional, legally recognized equivalent in another country
- ▶ Hold a master's, postgraduate, or doctoral degree* from an adult-gerontology primary care nurse practitioner program accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) or the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) (formerly NLNAC | National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission) A minimum of 500 faculty-supervised clinical hours must be included in the adult-gerontology primary care nurse practitioner role and population.
- ▶ Three separate, comprehensive graduate-level courses in:
 - ▶ Advanced physiology/pathophysiology, including general principles that apply across the lifespan
 - ▶ Advanced health assessment, which includes assessment of all human systems, advanced assessment techniques, concepts, and approaches
 - ▶ Advanced pharmacology, which includes pharmacodynamics, pharmacokinetics, and pharmacotherapeutics of all broad categories of agents
- ▶ Content in:
 - ▶ Health promotion and/or maintenance
 - ▶ Differential diagnosis and disease management, including the use and prescription of pharmacologic and nonpharmacologic interventions

WHAT TO EXPECT

This certification exam is a computer-based test. This means you can apply year-round and test during a 90-day window at a time and location convenient to you. Applications for this certification will be accepted at any time.

This certification exam is made up of 175 questions (150 scored plus 25 pretest questions that are not scored). You can see the subject areas covered on the exam and the approximate number of questions in each area by reading the Test Content Outline, available at www.nursingworld.org/our-certifications/ The time limit for the exam is 3.5 hours.

After you pass, certification renewal is every 5 years. Between renewals, you can enter and store your professional development credits online as you earn them, making renewal fast and easy! For full renewal requirements, visit www.nursingworld.org/our-certifications/

- ▶ Your transcript(s) (After you complete the online application, a pop-up screen will appear with instructions for submitting your transcript.)
- ▶ Your RN license number, state, and expiration date
