With RKPay, everything is done within the app - no checks or cash needed. In just a few minutes, you can sign up in the RollKall online portal so you can:

Where Can I Sign Up?

As an LEA, you sign up for RKPay using your online portal. You are also able to configure RollKall to require that all jobs posted are paid via RKPay, essentially requiring any business who works with your agency to sign up for RKPay. This helps your department make sure all jobs running through your agency are able to offer all possible benefits with each job.

How Does it Work?

Your LEA and coordinators sign up for RKPay so you can receive payments. Businesses are then able to pay via RKPay with a credit card or ACH transfer. They can also see individual invoices and make payments to all stakeholders. This includes paying the officer, paying coordinator fees, paying the law enforcement agency for any related fees, and processing the convenience fee of total officer invoice.
