What is the policy about?

As of February 2021, Quebec has put into effect an updated "Policy, Rules, and Procedures Regarding the Protection of the Integrity". Which places responsibility on sport federations and organizations to protect its members by providing them a safe, fair, and trusted environment.

What does the policy cover?

It covers all cases of abuse, harassment, negligence, or violence. New requirements for sport organizations include a formal process for dealing with complaints of abuse. While specific requirements are likely to change, our technology is highly adaptable to your organization's particular needs.

Who the new policy affects?

The policy applies to all those involved in the sport community including members, participants, parents, volunteers, employees, officers, suppliers, clients, etc.). In short- everyone!
