

The Social-Emotional Competency **Assessment (SECA)**



Devereux Student Strengths Assessment (DESSA)



The SECA (student-facing) and DESSA (teacherfacing) are grounded in resilience theory and aligned with the CASEL framework. They measure:

- Self-awareness
- Self-management
- Social-awareness
- Relationship skills
- Responsible decision-making
- Goal-directed behavior

Assessments can be administered up to three times across the school year to evaluate the progress of individuals or groups of students.

Student Risk Screening Scale -Internalizing and Externalizing (SRSS-IE)



The Student Risk Screening Scale - Internalizing and Externalizing (SRSS-IE) is a brief universal screening tool completed by teachers that helps identify students at risk for office discipline referrals, suspensions, and academic failure.

The IE in SRSS-IE stands for:

- 1. Internalizing behaviors that are directed inward such as withdrawal, depression, and anxiety. These are easily missed without a systematic screening tool.
- 2. Externalizing behaviors are directed outward and are more likely to be noticed, such as aggression, stealing, or cheating.

Using SEL Data to Guide Decision-Making and Planning

The Branching Minds platform includes several tools, features, and reports that summarize not only social and behavioral data, but also provide a series of actions that can be taken to ensure students are receiving needed support.





Bulk Tiering

- Leverage cut scores from behavioral screeners
- Identify students needing more targeted behavioral support
- Review tier placements and make adjustments

Tier Level Reporting


- See percent and number of students in each tier broken down by school, grade, gender, race, ethnicity, English proficiency, and FRL status
- Understand and evaluate the fidelity of support across tiers.

Cohort Assessment Performance Report

- See the specific strengths and challenge areas across cohorts of students
- Guide classroom teachers in Tier1SEL curriculum to focus on certain skills and competencies with which their students are struggling.
- Assist counselors, specialists, and social workers to identify groups of students with similar needs and/or develop targeted intervention plans.
