

JAPANESE CEDAR

Japanese Cedar's botanical name is Cryptomeria japonica. Japanese Cedar is grown in Japan and Northern China. It is from the same species family as Western Red Cedar and Redwood, therefore has features comparable to WRC, Incense, NWC and Redwood. Fencing is kiln dried prior to shipping, ensuring dimensional stability and easy installation.
