Responsibilities & Qualifications

Front-End Web Development and Publishing:

- Create technical specifications and develop responsive designs using PHP, JavaScript, jQuery, HTML5, and CSS3.
- Recommend custom WordPress themes, plug-ins and widgets to meet business requirements.
- Conduct cross-browser and cross-device testing to ensure consistent display.
- Manage a version-control system such as Git.
- Research and implement best practices for web performance, scalability, and accessibility.
- Execute content updates across the core platform.
- Ensure consistency of brand standards across multiple platforms.
- Knowledge of SEO best practices and experience with tools such as Google Analytics and Google Tag Manager

Back-End Web Development:

- Integrate data from various services and databases and manage integrations.
- Ensure consistency of data across multiple platforms including WordPress, Hubspot CRM, Attendify, Algolia and Recurly.

Core qualifications:

- 3 - 5 plus years of experience in front-end and back-end development.
- Advanced understanding of the Wordpress CMS including: custom themes, custom plugins, and framework methodologies.
- Knowledge of JavaScript, React, Node.JS, MySQL and PHP.
- Experience working with cloud native architecture such as AWS or Azure.
- Strong organizational skills to juggle multiple tasks and shifting priorities within the constraints of timelines and budgets.
- Familiarity with modern development workflow and project management, including Sketch, Figma, InVision, Git, Basecamp and JIRA.
- Experience working in an Agile environment.
- Excellent communication and documentation skills.
