## Acclimating your Vermont Plank Floor

- 1. Establish living conditions at the job site. Air conditioning and/or heating running for at least 5 days, windows & doors installed, all wet construction elements completely dried, for an ideal environment of 60-80° F at 35-50% relative humidity.
- 2. Ensure the moisture content of your subfloor is tested at multiple locations. We recommend 40 tests per 1000ft.
- 3. Your hardwood floor will arrive with approximately 7% moisture content. Your subfloor should measure within 3-4 % of the finished flooring.
- 4. To acclimate effectively, unpack the planks and stack to allow air circulation on all sides.
- 5. Your flooring is sufficiently acclimated when its moisture content is within 2% of the subfloor.
- 6. If the moisture content of the new planks and subfloor are within 2% upon arrival, we recommend 48 hours of acclimation before attempting to install.
- 7. Please be sure to discuss the acclimation process with your installer. This is only intended as a general guide as every installation is unique. Follow NWFA guidelines and the recommendations of your installer.
