"Vaccine mandate for East Bay's Peralta Community College District: Students and employees at the Peralta Community College District must be vaccinated or request a medical or religious exemption, interim Chancellor Jannett Jackson announced Friday. The district of 50,000 students has four campuses: Laney and Merritt colleges in Oakland, Alameda City College and Berkeley City College. Peralta appears to be the Bay Area's first community college district to require the public health measure. Unvaccinated employees and students must wear face masks and be tested weekly for COVID-19, Jackson said. Campuses will "open with limits" on Aug. 23."

Also mentioning the few colleges/districts that have been able to navigate vaccine requirements.
