

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE 3290 CONSUMER INFORMATION DISCLOSURES

The District is committed to providing its students, employees and community with a wide range of consumer information disclosures, as required by the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008. The consumer information disclosures include, but are not limited to:

- crime/security statistics
- student completion/graduation rates
- FERPA privacy/security rights
- financial aid program information
- gender-specific information on athletic participation
- financial support

These disclosures will be updated annually prior to October 1st of each academic year. The collection of this information will derive from the District's Institutional Research Office in collaboration with the Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs (or designee), in collaboration with the college Vice Presidents of Student Services. The annual disclosure notice will be provided to students and employees in October of each academic year and hard copies will be made available at each college upon request.
