- Carry forward item from March 2014
- Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)
- <u>Background</u>: In order for the self-funded plan to conform to the *Mental Health Parity Act*, we need to formally adopt provisions which bring coverage for ADHD into alignment with the Americans with Disability Act
 - Currently:
 - We cover initial diagnosis
 - We cover precriptions
 - We do not cover on-going treatment plan

- Get an approval from your doctor before you switch to another drug company's brand (generic or brand-name).
- Keep note of any changes you may feel after switching from a brand-name to a generic and tell your doctor.


