


Q3 - Which PCCD college(s) are you expecting to teach at this fall 2020? (please select


## Q4 - Do you have a desktop or laptop with a webcam?






## Q8 - Have you taken and successfully completed a course on the use of Canvas?

## Q9 - Have you received training in how to use Canvas?





It's hard to answer some of the above questions with a clear yes or no - it's not clear how the self-paced Canvas course counts or not, and I'm signed up for some things already, not interested in more classes than what I'm already signed up for. But I AM interested in more individualized help, such as once I have my courses set up for fall, someone could look and be able to say "fix this" or "this is adequate but here are 3 specific ways to improve" something along those lines. I appreciate that this is a challenging situation to respond to as an institution and I'm grateful for the folks who are helping those of us who have not taught online outside of the emergency we had in fall. I hope those folks are getting appropriately compensated for their work, and I hope those of us who never intended to teach online will be appropriately compensated for our time learning and implementing our new skills as well.

My only concern is that I have already completed this questionnaire before, but the prompt window says that I have not, so I'm doing it a second time!

I just enrolled in a qualifying Canvas Course. No day or time listed yet. I have to make up labs with my students in the evenings during the same dates as the course so I am concerned about whether I can participate or work around the specific time period for the class.

How soon will we learn whether we have student registered for our courses?

There is such confusion over what constitutes meeting the requirements for the AP4105 on training in canvas. If you have a robust Canvas shell and have taken training on how to use canvas why should you take a beginning class in how to use canvas? Why are there not intermediate classes set up for those people who were using canvas effectively before? Do we have to spend time (unpaid) taking a class that doesn't really meet the needs of people who were already effective at Canvas because they took canvas trainings over the past few years during professional development instead of a class taught by Merritt through EDT?

Most of the answers to these questions can be found on the Canvas site and youtube. I do not think formal training is necessary and should not be required for those who take advantage of the wealth of materials available on the web.

Course readers that are ADA compliant for students with reading disabilities. I have these, but I am concerned that some instructors don't. This needs to be a top priority for online-only instruction for every course.

My other ideas are related to applications we are learning about to enhance our online courses. Many of them are fee-based or the free versions are limited. Would it be possible for PCCD to purchase faculty subscriptions for online learning resources? Also, our students have access to Kanopy to watch films. However, the licenses that Laney has limited film options. I have worked with the librarian to get more (AFRAM) films added but was told the license would only last 1-year. This is important because I will teach a film course online in the Fall. Normally I would use DVDs for a face-to-face class. Or least a combination of DVDs and online viewing platforms. The challenge getting free access for students to watch films. Kanopy is a good resource, but it's limited. Thank you for reaching out to learn what we need!

I'm teaching summer course of Gen Chem at BCC so if the short-term workshop is scheduled after summer session then, A laptop with webcam and a tablet to write will definitely help.

Since I am teaching on line this summer I am going to have difficulty fitting in courses to qualify me to teach on line.

I teach Studio Art (Drawing, Painting, and Sculpture). Access to a Wacom tablet is necessary for art demonstrations. I believe BCC's Multimedia Arts department has some, but they have not responded to my emails.

As program coordinator for anthropology, we need to provide a summer stipend for individuals who are taking lab sections and transitioning these to the online format. This is a completely different process than transitioning a lecture course. Please provide lab instructors with a stipend during spring 2020 to prepare for the fall semester. A stipend of \$5,000 is being offered at other colleges to help with this transition.

I have some questions how instructors need to take courses and learn more bells and whistles when students may not have the interest or technical expertise to access "new and improved" bells and whistles

I am not able to attend any of the summer workshops because I will be teaching this summer. As an adjunct, some of the timing of workshops are incredibly hard to manage because I am also trying not to burn out by constant cycles of applying to other jobs (requirement of unemployment), updating my own classes, and then trying to watch YouTube videos/links already available. and seeing what online lab simulations will be best for my students.

Can the stipended classes offered in Spring be offered in Summer?

I like to use summer to take courses but when I teach summer school it is hard to do both.

We need to provide greater online training opportunities for faculty as well as how-to navigation workshops for students. Merritt College provides a certification program in learning how to teach with Canvas; however, they don't offer regularly or ever (I've been waiting for two years) all of the courses required in order to satisfy the certificate requirements, which makes the certificate impossible to complete and, arguably, pointless to offer. We need to do better than this because our current practices undermine and contradict our pronounced expectations, demands, and requirements.

My online teaching experience (answered above) reflects only THIS SEMSTER'S emergency shift to online.

The computer that I have is a loaner from Laney IT. Will I be able to continue using it?

It takes a lot of labor and time to build effective and engaging asynchronous online courses that are not just correspondence. Faculty labor and time should be accounted for given the extra time it takes to create and prep online modules. I have been teaching online and hybrid courses since 2014 and online courses require more labor, time and work if they are done right.

I am thinking of taking the 2 classes at Merritt, but would certainly be interested in others, need to know how to record class ahead of time.

Textbook choices for online classes

As an art instructor, I've recently become aware that images can be uploaded to search for related information. This makes giving tests using images challenging—I'm still looking for solutions

my computer is having problems with multiple program open when zooming.

As part-time instructor, online instruction takes a lot longer to lesson plan, set up and assist students' needs. Especially, those that are not to familiar with virtual instruction. Therefore, the amount of paid time allocated for instructors needs to be adjusted.

No. I am currently taking the "humanizing" course and have signed up for a Canvas course. I typically don't attend Workshops because attendees all have different proficiency levels. I can usually figure things out by looking it up on the Internet and if I still don't understand, I'll drop in on a trainer's office hours.

I'm concern about the ownership of my intellectual property in Canvas.

I'm concerned that there is a general lack of support to train faculty in DE education in the face of the current emergency situation, since most faculty are not DE ready, but are now required to be by Fall 2020.

Our students need labs to reinforce the learning. Canvas has it's issues. there are too many apps we are being asked to learn...too much focus right now in method(s), less on getting the point across.
