Architect needs to be hired because this 	



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	<p>project needs to be reviewed by DSA (Department of State Architect).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ For Merritt College; elevator vertical hydraulic lift shafts need to be replaced.○ For BCC (Berkeley City College) Elevator, waiting for parts delivery.○ District-Wide Elevator Modernization Project: AECOM Team to coordinate the project for each campus. <p>▪ Fire Alarms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ For Merritt and Laney Campuses – Repair and modernization is currently in progress. Target date for completion is March 13th. Oakland Fire Department is expected week of March 16th for inspection. This will determine if the campuses will be off or continue to be on Fire Watch.○ Next locations to be inspected; BCC (Berkeley City College) and COA (College of Alameda). <p>▪ Project Status:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Laney Transformer has been replaced.○ Laney Parking Lot lights has been restored. With additional assessment, 15% are still out and replacement parts are not available. Looking at alternative plans to get the lights working again.○ Laney Welding Lab safety issue has been addressed and the work is near completion. Welding Lab is now available.	
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	<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ COA Transformer; issue was underground wiring and electrical lines which are now replaced. New Center for Liberal Arts building includes a Transformer which will bring additional power to the campus.○ Laney Art Building:<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Electrical boxes needed to be plated over. Project completed.▪ Sump Pump was replaced.○ Laney Campus-Wide:<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Inoperable doors. Out of 570 doors, 18 still need to be 100% operable to meet current code. Target date to complete this project, end of April. Affecting the doors are the HVAC systems making it difficult to open.○ Doors at the District and COA Air Program still need addressing.○ BCC:<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Project Team continue to work on ADA issues.▪ Kitchel Team currently working on bathroom signage, upgrades and moving furniture○ Laney:<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Music Lift project is now completed.▪ Theater Lift will be replaced prior to the future upgrade because of current challenges, risk is too high.	
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	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Locker Room Project; design build project for Swinerton Management and Consulting has been designated Project Manager (PM) and Construction Manager (CM). In coordination with Taylor Design, the project is progressing well.▪ Glass replacement throughout the campus completed.▪ IT Classroom upgrade completed.○ College of Alameda:<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Airframe building, replace the HVAC system.▪ Fire Sprinkler line replacement, project is halfway completed. Project will be completed following March 24th Board Meeting.▪ Underground leaky fire sprinkler system resulted with flooding next to an existing building. With the collaboration with the Purchasing Team and on-site Construction Manager, the sprinkler system was fixed over the weekend. Final repair to take place after March 24th Board Meeting.
