

# Home Generator Installation: 3 Part Process

## PART 1

### Schedule a Free Quote



Do your initial research and reach out to an expert.

### Size and Add-ons

Determine the size & add-ons for your generator (switch, modules, etc.)

### Location

We'll find the most cost effective location to place your generator around the house

### Placement

Determine if any landscaping needs to be done or structures need to be built.

### Electrical/Plumbing

Determine if you will use your own electrical contractors and plumbers, or use those provided by your generator company (as necessary).

### Receive a Quote



Sign terms & conditions, and pay a 50% deposit.

You sign Terms and Conditions and pay 50% Deposit for Project.



## PART 2

### Generator Order

At this point, we'll order your generator and all related parts.

### Communications

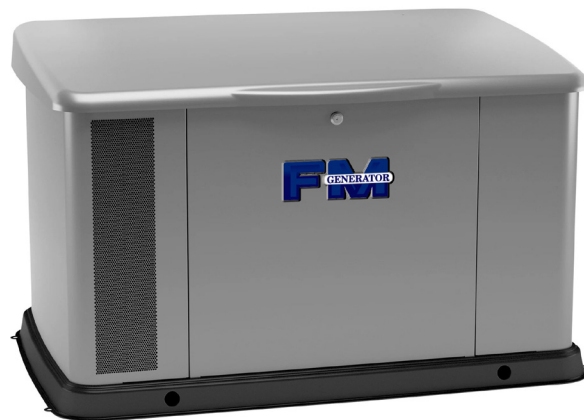
We'll coordinate with the contractors to ensure all work is properly completed.

### Delivery & Installation



Your generator is delivered and set up for installation.

### Final Payment

30% of the payment will be due upon delivery, with the final 20% due upon final start-up.



### Inspection

An electrical and plumbing inspector approves all work performed. All proper permits must be present.
